Flower 5 is approx 6 cm, 2½ in, in diameter
Flower 6 is approx 8 cm, 3¼ in, in diameter
Flower 7 is approx 4½ cm, 1¾ in, in diameter
Flower 8 is approx 6½ cm, 2½ in, in diameter
Flower 9 is approx 5½ cm, 2¼ in, in diameter

- Small amounts of Paintbox Yarns Simply DK in each of A - (Champagne White, Raspberry Pink, Sailor Blue, Daffodil Yellow, Tomato Red, Buttercup Yellow, Tea Rose, Ballet Pink, Slate Green, Dark Aubergine or Blood Orange) and B - (Champagne White, Raspberry Pink, Daffodil Yellow, Tomato Red, Buttercup Yellow, Tea Rose, Ballet Pink, Slate Green, Rich Mauve, Dark Aubergine, Sky Blue, Kingfisher Blue, Blood Orange or Racing Green)

Flowers 4, 6 and 8

- Small amounts of Paintbox Yarns Simply DK in each of A - (Champagne White, Raspberry Pink, Sailor Blue, Daffodil Yellow, Tomato Red, Buttercup Yellow, Tea Rose, Slate Green, Dark Aubergine or Blood Orange), B - (Raspberry Pink, Daffodil Yellow, Tomato Red, Buttercup Yellow, Tea Rose, Ballet Pink, Slate Green, Rich Mauve, Dark Aubergine, Sky Blue, Kingfisher Blue or Blood Orange) and C - (Daffodil Yellow, Ballet Pink, Buttercup Yellow, Tea Rose or Slate Green)

- 3.5mm (UK 9 – US E4) crochet hook
- Length of string, approx 450 cm, 177 in

TENSION (GAUGE)

It is vitally important that your tension (*gauge*) is correct if you want to achieve the stated measurement. If your item is smaller than the stated measurement, try again using a thicker hook. If it is bigger than the stated measurement, try again using a thinner hook.

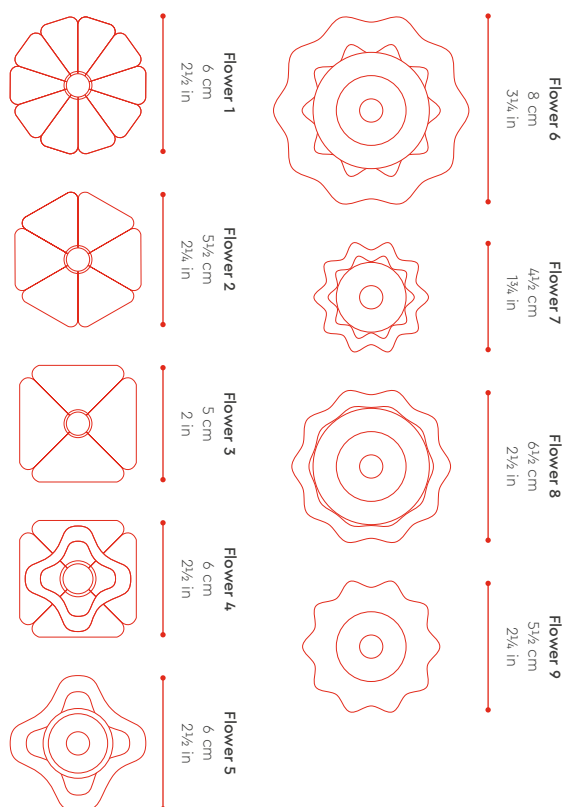
GOOD TO KNOW

beg = beginning; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimetres; **dc (sc)** = double (*single*) crochet; **dtr (tr)** = double treble (*treble*); **htr (hdc)** = half treble (*half double crochet*); **in** = inches; **mm** = millimetre; **rep** = repeat; **rs** = right side; **sp(s)** = space(s); **ss** = slip stitch; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr (dc)** = treble (*double crochet*).

FLOWER 1 (MAKE 4)

Make 4 ch using 3.5mm (UK 9 – US E4) crochet hook and A and join with ss to form a ring.

round 1 (rs) 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 10 dc (*sc*) into ring, ss to first dc (*sc*).

Break A and join in B.

round 2 using B, 4 ch, (4 dtr (*tr*), 4 ch, 1 ss) into st at base of first 4 ch, *ss into next dc (*sc*), 4 ch, (4 dtr (*tr*), 4 ch, 1 ss) into same dc (*sc*), rep from * 8 times more.

Fasten off.

FLOWER 2 (MAKE 4)

Make 4 ch using 3.5mm (UK 9 – US E4) crochet hook and A and join with ss to form a ring.

round 1 (rs) 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 6 dc (*sc*) into ring, ss to first dc (*sc*).

Break A and join in B.

round 2 using B, (4 ch, 4 dtr (*tr*), 4 ch, 1 ss) into st at base of first 4 ch, *(1 ss, 4 ch, 4 dtr (*tr*), 4 ch, 1 ss) into next dc (*sc*), rep from * 4 times more.

Fasten off.

FLOWER 3 (MAKE 5)

Make 4 ch using 3.5mm (UK 9 – US E4) crochet hook and A and join with ss to form a ring.

round 1 (rs) 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 8 dc (*sc*) into ring, ss to first dc (*sc*).

Break A and join in B.

round 2 using B, 4 ch, 2 dtr (*tr*) into st at base of 4 ch, (2 dtr (*tr*), 4 ch, 1 ss) into next dc (*sc*), *(1 ss, 4 ch, 2 dtr (*tr*)) into next dc (*sc*), (2 dtr (*tr*), 4 ch and 1 ss) into next dc (*sc*), rep from * twice more.

Fasten off.

FLOWER 4 (MAKE 4)

Make 4 ch using 3.5mm (UK 9 – US E4) crochet hook and A and join with ss to form a ring.

round 1 (rs) 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 8 dc (*sc*) into ring, ss to first dc (*sc*).

Break A and join in B.

round 2 using B, 4 ch, 2 dtr (*tr*) into st at base of 4 ch, (2 dtr (*tr*), 4 ch, 1 ss) into next dc (*sc*), *(1 ss, 4 ch, 2 dtr (*tr*)) into next dc (*sc*), (2 dtr (*tr*), 4 ch and 1 ss) into next dc (*sc*), rep from * twice more, ss into first dc (*sc*) of round 1. (4 petals).

Break B and join in C.

round 3 working in front of petals made in round 2, (4 ch, ss into dc at base of next 2 petals) 3 times, 4 ch, ss into ss at end of round 2.

round 4 1 ch (does NOT count as st), (1 dc (*sc*), 3 htr (*hdc*)) into each 4-ch loop of round 3, ss into first dc (*sc*).



FLOWER 5 (MAKE 2)

Flower

Make 2 ch using 3.5mm (UK 9 – US E4) crochet hook and A.

round 1 (rs) 8 dc (*sc*) into 2nd ch from hook, ss to first dc (*sc*).

round 2 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 2 dc (*sc*) into st at base of 1 ch, (2 dc (*sc*) into next dc (*sc*)) 7 times, ss to first dc (*sc*). 16 sts.

round 3 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc (*sc*) into st at base of 1 ch, 1 dc (*sc*) into each of next 15 dc (*sc*), ss to first dc (*sc*).

rounds 4 and 5 as round 3.

round 6 8 ch, miss st at base of 8 ch and next 3 sts, ss into next st, (8 ch, miss 3 sts, ss into next st) twice, 8 ch, miss 3 sts, ss into st at base of first 8 ch of round.

round 7 (1 dc (*sc*), 2 htr (*hdc*), 1 tr (*dc*), 1 dtr (*tr*), 1 tr (*dc*), 2 htr (*hdc*), 1 dc (*sc*)) into each 8-ch loop, ss to first dc (*sc*). Fasten off.

Flower Centre

Make 2 ch using 3.5mm (UK 9 – US E4) crochet hook and B.

round 1 (rs) 5 dc (*sc*) into 2nd ch from hook, ss to first dc (*sc*).

round 2 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 3 dc (*sc*) into st at base of 1 ch, (3 dc (*sc*) into next dc (*sc*)) 4 times, ss to first dc (*sc*). Fasten off.

Sew Flower Centre securely to inside of Flower.

FLOWER 6 (MAKE 4)

Make 5 ch using 3.5mm (UK 9 – US E4) crochet hook and A and join with ss to form a ring.

round 1 (rs) 3 ch (counts as 1 htr (*hdc*) and 1 ch), (1 htr (*hdc*) into ring, 1 ch) 9 times, ss into 2nd of 3 ch at beg of round. Break A and join in B.

round 2 using B, ss into next ch sp, 3 ch (counts as 1 tr (*dc*)), 1 tr (*dc*) into same ch sp, (1 ch, 2 tr (*dc*) into next ch sp) 9 times, 1 ch, ss to top of 3 ch at beg of round.

Break B and join in C.

round 3 using C, ss into next ch sp, 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc (*sc*) into same ch sp, (5 ch, 1 dc (*sc*) into next ch sp) 9 times, 5 ch, ss to first dc (*sc*).

round 4 using C, ss into next 5-ch loop, (1 dc (*sc*), 1 htr (*hdc*), 1 tr (*dc*), 1 htr (*hdc*), 1 dc (*sc*)) into each 5-ch loop, ss to first dc (*sc*).

Fasten off.

FLOWER 7 (MAKE 3)

Make 5 ch using 3.5mm (UK 9 – US E4) crochet hook and A and join with ss to form a ring.

round 1 (rs) 3 ch (counts as 1 htr (*hdc*) and 1 ch), (1 htr (*hdc*) into ring, 1 ch) 9 times, ss into 2nd of 3 ch at beg of round. Break A and join in B.

round 2 using B, ss into next ch sp, 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc (*sc*) into same ch sp, (5 ch, 1 dc (*sc*) into next ch sp) 9 times, 5 ch, ss to first dc (*sc*).

Fasten off.

FLOWER 8 (MAKE 4)

Make 5 ch using 3.5mm (UK 9 – US E4) crochet hook and A and join with ss to form a ring.

round 1 (rs) 3 ch (counts as 1 htr (*hdc*) and 1 ch), (1 htr (*hdc*) into ring, 1 ch) 9 times, ss into 2nd of 3 ch at beg of round. Break A and join in B.

round 2 using B, ss into next ch sp, 3 ch (counts as 1 tr (*dc*)), 1 tr (*dc*) into same ch sp, (1 ch, 2 tr (*dc*) into next ch sp) 9 times, 1 ch, ss to top of 3 ch at beg of round.

Break B and join in C.

round 3 using C, ss into next ch sp, 1 ch (does NOT count as st), (1 dc (*sc*), 1 htr (*hdc*), 1 tr (*dc*), 1 htr (*hdc*), 1 dc (*sc*)) into same ch sp, *(1 dc (*sc*), 1 htr (*hdc*), 1 tr (*dc*), 1 htr (*hdc*), 1 dc (*sc*)) into next ch sp, rep from * 8 times more, ss to first dc (*sc*). Fasten off.

FLOWER 9 (MAKE 3)

Make 5 ch using 3.5mm (UK 9 – US E4) crochet hook and A and join with ss to form a ring.

round 1 (rs) 4 ch (counts as 1 tr (*dc*) and 1 ch), (1 tr (*dc*) into ring, 1 ch) 9 times, ss into 3rd of 4 ch at beg of round. Break A and join in B.

round 2 using B, ss into next ch sp, 1 ch (does NOT count as st), (1 dc (*sc*), 1 htr (*hdc*), 1 tr (*dc*), 1 htr (*hdc*), 1 dc (*sc*)) into same ch sp, *(1 dc (*sc*), 1 htr (*hdc*), 1 tr (*dc*), 1 htr (*hdc*), 1 dc (*sc*)) into next ch sp, rep from * 8 times more, ss to first dc (*sc*). Fasten off.
