All-in-One Washcloth and Scrubby

Great for using in the kitchen or in the shower as a body scrubber. These double sided scrubbies are so versatile and easy to make you will want to give one to everyone you know. Crocheted in the round using single, half and double crochet stitches. Pattern also includes a variation to make a sunflower scrubby as well.

Skill Level: Advanced Beginner

Gauge: 13sc X14 rows = 10 cm X 10 cm

Materials:

H-(5mm) crochet hook
scissors
stitch marker
yarn needle
Red Heart Scrubby Yarn (color of your choice)
Bernat Cotton Yarn (color of your choice)



Abbreviations:

MR- Magic Ring
DC- Double Crochet
sl st- slip stitch
SC- Single Crochet
Hdc- Half Double Crochet
Ch-Chain
sts- stitches
PM
Tr- Treble Crochet
Picot- Picot stitch is done at the top of the treble crochet by chaining 2 then slip stitch through the two loops at the top of the treble crochet.

Instructions:

START with SCRUBBY yarn ****Note for the scrubby yarn**** working with this yarn is a little hard to see the stitches sometimes so I always use a stitch marker at the beginning of the round so I know where to join.

Begin with a MR

Round 1: DC times 10 into MR and pull tight to form a circle. Join with a sl st. (10 sts)

Round 2: Ch 2, (2 DC) into each stitch all the way around. Join with a sl st. (20 sts)

Round 3: Ch 2 *2 DC, 1 DC* repeat from between the * all the way around. Join with a sl st (30 sts)

Cut yarn, leaving a small tail for weaving into your work.

CHANGE to Cotton Yarn

Begin with a MR

Round 1: DC times 10 into MR and pull tight to form a circle. Join with a sl st. (10 sts)

Round 2: Ch 2, (2 DC) into each stitch all the way around. Join with a sl st. (20 sts)

Round 3: Ch 2 *2 DC, 1 DC* repeat from between the * all the way around. Join with a sl st (30 sts)

Round 4: Ch 1, here you will want to get the scrubby circle that you just created to join to the cotton circle. Lining up the stitches as you go work through both circles in this pattern *2sc, 1sc, 1sc* repeat from between the * until the end of the round. Join with a sl st. (40 sts)

Round 5: *skip one stitch, Hdc, Hdc, DC, DC, Hdc, Hdc, skip one stitch, sl st into next stitch* repeat from between the * until the end of round ending at a sl st.

Cut yarn and weave in ends.

Sunflower Variation

To create the sunflower you will need Red Heart Scrubby ALMOND yarn and Bernat cotton PALE YELLOW yarn.

Follow the pattern above until Round 5. For the last round you will *skip one stitch, Hdc, DC, Tr (picot) DC, Hdc, skip one stitch. sl st into the next * repeat from between the * until the end of the round ending with a sl st.
