

Bunny and Bear in Blue Jeans - Crochet Pattern by Flo and Dot



You will need:

3.5mm crochet hook

Polyester filling

Safety eyes (8 to 10mm)

A small amount of black cotton yarn or embroidery thread for his nose.

For the bunny:

50g balls Paintbox Yarns Cotton DK

1 x Stormy Grey (405)

1 x Dolphin Blue (437)

1 x Paper White (401)

1 x Sailor Blue (440)

Optional: To make carrots you will need a small amount of orange and green yarn. (Blood Orange (420), Grass Green (430))

Finished size: Approximately 27cm tall (from the top of his ears to his feet) by 11cm wide.

For the bear:

50g balls Paintbox Yarns Cotton DK

1 x Soft Fudge (410)

1 x Dolphin Blue (437)

Finished size: Approximately 24cm tall (from the top of his ears to his feet) by 11cm wide.

This pattern is written in UK terms (1dc is equivalent to 1sc in US terms)

ch - chain

st - stitch

dc - double crochet

dec - decrease (dc two together)

sl st - slip stitch

Tip: For a neater finish when joining yarn, attach the new colour just before completing the last stitch i.e. before the final yarn over hook.

Bunny

Work in continuous rounds throughout unless stated.

Legs (make 2)

Using Stormy Grey, ch 2

Round 1 8dc in second chain from hook (8)

Round 2 2dc in each st around (16)

Round 3 to 6 16dc

Join Dolphin Blue

Round 7 to 10 16dc

Fasten off

Note: Make the second leg in the same way but at the end of round 10 **do not fasten off** instead ch 6 and join with a sl st to last dc on first leg. Continue in Dolphin Blue to make the body.

Body

Round 11 16dc around first leg, 6dc along 6ch, 16dc around second leg, 6dc along other side of 6ch (44)

Round 12 to 19 44dc

Round 20 8dc, dec, 20dc, dec, 12dc (42)

Round 21 42dc

Round 22 19dc, dec, 19dc, dec (40)

Join Paper White

Round 23 4dc, dc in the back loop of the next 2sts (these unworked loops are where you will attach the straps), 8dc, dc in the back loop of the next 2sts, 8dc, dc in the back loop of the next 2sts, 8dc, dc in the back loop of the next 2sts, 4dc (40)

Round 24 9dc, dec, 18dc, dec, 9dc (38)

Join Sailor Blue

Tip: Rather than cutting the yarn carry the Paper White and Sailor Blue yarn up on the inside until it is required.

Round 25 38dc

Round 26 Dec, 17dc, dec, 17dc (36)

Using Paper White

Round 27 36dc

Round 28 (4dc, dec) six times (30)

Using Sailor Blue

Round 29 30dc

Round 30 (3dc, dec) six times (24)

Using Paper White

Round 31 24dc

Round 32 (2dc, dec) six times (18)

Using Sailor Blue

Round 33 18dc

Round 34 (dc, dec) six times (12)

Fasten off.

Head

Using Stormy Grey, ch 2

Round 1 6dc in second chain from hook (6)

Round 2 2dc in each st around (12)

Round 3 (dc, 2dc in next st) six times (18)

Round 4 (2dc, 2dc in next st) six times (24)

Round 5 (3dc, 2dc in next st) six times (30)

Round 6 (4dc, 2dc in next st) six times (36)

Round 7 to 12 36dc

Round 13 (4dc, dec) six times (30)

Round 14 (3dc, dec) six times (24)

Round 15 (2dc, dec) six times (18)

Round 16 (dc, dec) six times (12)

Fasten off leaving a long thread to attach head to body.

Ears (make 2)

Using Stormy Grey, ch 2

Round 1 6dc in second chain from hook (6)

Round 2 (dc, 2dc in next st) three times (9)

Round 3 (2dc, 2dc in next st) three times (12)

Round 4 to 9 12dc

Round 10 (2dc, dec) three times (9)

Round 11 to 12 9dc

Round 13 (dc, dec) three times (6)

Round 14 6dc

Fasten off leaving a long thread to attach ears to head.

Arms (make 2)

Using Stormy Grey, ch 2

Round 1 6dc in second chain from hook (6)

Round 2 (dc, 2dc in next st) three times (9)

Round 3 to 5 9dc

Join Paper White

Round 6 to 7 9dc

Join Sailor Blue

Tip: Rather than cutting the yarn carry the Paper White and Sailor Blue yarn up on the inside until it is required.

Round 8 to 9 9dc

Round 10 to 19 Continue working two rows Paper White followed by two rows Sailor Blue until end.

Fasten off leaving a long thread to attach arms to body.

Tail

Using Paper White, ch 2

Round 1 6dc in second chain from hook (6)

Round 2 2dc in each st around (12)

Round 3 to 5 12 dc

Round 6 Dec six times (6)

Fasten off leaving a long thread to attach tail to body.

Jeans Pocket

Using Dolphin Blue, ch 9

Row 1 Dc in second chain from hook, dc to end, ch 1, turn (8)

Row 2 2dc in first st, 7dc, ch 1, turn (9)

Row 3 2dc in first st, 8dc, ch 1, turn (10)

Row 4 to 6 10dc, ch 1, turn

Row 7 10dc

Fasten off leaving a long thread to attach pocket to jeans.

Bear

As for Bunny but make body and arms plain using Soft Fudge.

Ears (make 2)

Using Soft Fudge, ch 2

Round 1 6dc in second chain from hook (6)

Round 2 (dc, 2dc in next st) three times (9)

Round 3 (2dc, 2dc in next st) three times (12)

Round 4 to 5 12dc

Round 6 (2dc, dec) three times (9)

Fasten off leaving a long thread to attach ears to head.

To finish

Using the picture as a guide attach the safety eyes and embroider a nose. Stuff the head and body and sew together. Sew on the ears. Next stuff the arms three quarters full and sew to the body.

To make straps attach Dolphin Blue yarn to first of two unworked loops on the back of the bunny or bear, ch1, work 1 dc in each unworked loop (2), ch 1, turn, * 2dc, ch 1, turn, repeat from * until 24 rows worked, bring strap over to the front and dc 2, working in both the previous row and the unworked loops at the front of the bunny or bear. Fasten off and weave in ends. Repeat for second strap.

Attach pocket to front of jeans. Finally stuff the tail and sew to body. Weave in any remaining ends.

Carrots (make as many as you wish, all bunnies love carrots!)

Using Blood Orange, ch 2

Round 1 4dc in second chain from hook (4)

Round 2 2dc in first st, 3dc (5)

Round 3 5dc

Round 4 4dc, 2dc in last st (6)

Round 5 6dc

Round 6 2dc, 2dc in next st, 3dc (7)

Round 7 7dc

Round 8 6dc, 2dc in last st (8)

Round 9 to 10 8dc

Round 11 Dec four times (4)

Join Grass Green

Dc, 10ch, dc in next st, 10ch, repeat until four leaves made, join with a sl st to first dc
Fasten off and weave in ends.
